<p>STRAIGHT PARTY VOTING</p> <p>a. Unless otherwise noted, a Straight Party vote is a vote for ALL candidates of that party in PARTISAN OFFICES. It is not necessary to mark individual candidates for PARTISAN OFFICES if you vote a Straight Party.</p> <p>b. You may vote a Straight Party AND ALSO vote for a candidate of a different party in any individual office.</p> <p>c. In any multi-seat office, a Straight Party vote is a vote for ALL candidates of that party. If you individually vote for any candidate in a multi-seat office, you must also individually mark all other candidates in that office for whom you wish to vote in order for all votes for that office to be counted.</p> <p>d. If you do not vote a Straight Party below, you may vote by marking each office separately.</p> <p>e.
