

**NOTICE OF SECOND PRIMARY ELECTION
BEAUFORT COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA**

The statewide republican second primary will be held on Tuesday, May 14, 2024.

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day. Voters must go to their assigned precinct on Election Day.

Voters will be asked to show photo ID when they vote. All voters will be allowed to vote with or without ID. Voters who lack ID can get one for free from their county board of elections. Find out more at BringItNC.com.

Absentee ballots will be mailed to voters who have requested them as soon as they are available. A voter can fill out an absentee ballot request at votebymail.ncsbe.gov, or by filling out a request form provided by the board of elections. The request must be received through the website or by the Beaufort County Board of Elections by 5 p.m. May 7, 2024.

In the second primary election, voters will select nominees for republican NC Lieutenant Governor and republican NC Auditor to move on to the November 5th general election. All voters who are registered with the Republican Party are eligible to vote in the second primary. Additionally, voters who are not affiliated with any party and who either didn't vote in the first primary or voted republican in the first primary are eligible to participate.
